Monday in the Octave of Easter Mass I, Lux et Origo Gloria GR 710

Introit 'O filii' (Plainsong for Schools) or Exodus 13,: 5,59 & Psalm 104 GR 200

Introduxit vos Dominus in terram fluentem lac et mel, alleluia: et ut lex Domini semper sit in ore vestro, alleluia, alleluia. Ps Confitemini Domino, et invocate nomen eius: annunciate inter gentes opera eius.

The Lord hath brought you into a land flowing with milk and honey, alleluia: that the the law of the Lord may ever be in your mouth, alleluia alleluia. Ps Give glory to the Lord, and call upon His name: make known His deeds among the nations.

Gradual Psalm 117:2 GR 201et 196.

Haec dies, quam fecit Dominus exultemus, et laetemur in ea. V Dicat nunc Israel, quoniam bonus: quoniam in saeculum misericordia eius.

This is the day that the Lord has made: let us be rejoice and be glad in it. V Let Isreal again say that He is good, that His mercy endureth for ever.

Alleluia Matthew 28: 2 GR 201

Angelus Domini descendit de caelo: et accedens revolvit lapidem, et sedebat super eum.

An angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and coming, rolled away the stone and sat upon it.

An angel of the Lord descended from heaven and said to the women: 'He whom you seek is risen as He said Alleluia'.

Communion Luke 24: 34 GR 202

Surrexit Dominus, et apparuit Petro, alleluia.

The Lord is risen, and hath appeared to Peter Alleluia.

Tuesday in the Octave of Easter Mass I, Lux et Origo Gloria GR 710

Introit Sirach [Ecclesiasticus] 15: 3,4 GR 202

Aqua sapientiae potavit Eos, alleluia: firmabitur in illis, et non flectetur, alleluia: et exaltabit Eos in aeternum alleluia, alleluia.

He gave them water of wisdom to drink, alleluia: it shall be made strong in them, and they shall not be moved, alleluia, and it shall exalt them forever, alleluia, alleluia.

Gradual psalm 117: 24; 106: 2 GR 203
Haec dies, quam fecit Dominus exultemus, et laetemur in ea. V Dicant nunc, qui redempti sunt a Domino: quos redemit de manu inimici, et de regionibus congregavit eos.
This is the day that the Lord has made: let us be rejoice and be glad in it. V Let those again speak who have been redeemed by our Lord: whom He hath redeemed out of the hand of the enemy, and gathered out of the nations.

Alleluia GR 203
Surrexit Dominus de sepulchro, qui pro nobis pependit in ligno.
The Lord is risen from the sepulchre, who for us hung upon a tree.

Offertory psalm 17: 14, 16 GR 204
Intonuit de caelo Dominus, et Altissimus dedit vocem suam: et apparuerunt fontes aquarum, alleluia.
The Lord thundered from heaven, and the Most High gave His voice: and the fountains of waters appeared, alleluia

Communion Colossians 3: 1-2 GR 205
Si consurrexistis cum Christo, quae sursum sunt quaerite, alleluia, ubi Christus est in dextera Dei sedens, alleluia: quae sursum sunt sapite, alleluia.
If you be risen with Christ seek the things that are above, where Christ is sitting at the right hand of God, alleluia; taste the things that are above, alleluia.

Wednesday in the Octave of Easter Mass I, Lux et Origo Gloria GR 710
Introit Matthew 25: 34; GR 205
Venite, benedicti Patris mei, percipite regnum, alleluia: quod vobis paratum est ab origine mundi, alleluia.
Come, blessed of My Father, receive the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

Gradual psalm 117; 24; 16 GR 206
Haec dies, quam fecit Dominus exultemus, et laetemur in ea. V Dextera Domini fecit virtutem, Dextera Domini exaltavit me.
This is the day that the Lord has made: let us be rejoice and be glad in it. V the right hand of the Lord hath wrought strength: the right hand of the Lord hath exalted me.

Alleluia Luke 24: 34 GR 206
Surrexit Dominus vere: et apparuit Petro.
The Lord is risen indeed; and hath appeared to Peter.

Sequence as for Monday GR 198

Offertory psalm 77: 23,24,25 GR 207
Portas caeli aperuit Dominus: et pluit illis manna, ut ederent: panem caeli dedit eis: panem Angelorum manducavit homo, alleluia
The Lord opened the doors of heaven, and rained down manna upon them to eat: He gave them the bread of heaven: man ate the bread of angels, alleluia.

Communion Romans 6: 9 Gr 207
Christus resurgens ex mortuis, jam non moritur, alleluia: mors illi ultra non dominabitur, alleluia.
Christ, rising again from the dead, dieth now no more, alleluia; death shall no more have dominion over Him, alleluia.

Thursday in the Octave of Easter Mass I, Lux et Origo Gloria GR 710
Introit Wisdom 10: 20-21 GR 208

Victricem manum tuam, Domine, laudaverunt pariter, alleluia: quia sapientia aperuit os mutum, et linguas infantium fecit disertas, alleluia.

They praised with one accord Thy victorious hand, O Lord, alleluia; for wisdom opened the mouth of the dumb, and made the tongues of infants eloquent, alleluia, alleluia.

Gradual psalm 117: 24, 22-23 GR 209

Haec dies, quam fecit Dominus exsultemus, et laetemur in ea. V Lapidem, quem reprobaverunt aedificantes, hic factus est in caput anguli: a Domino factum est istud, et est mirabile in oculis nostris.

This is the day that the Lord has made: let us be rejoice and be glad in it. V The stone which the builders rejected is become the head of the corner: this is the work of the Lord, and it is wonderful in our eyes.

Alleluia GR 209

Surrexit Christus, qui creavit omnia: et misertus est humano generi.

Christ is risen, Who created all things, and Who had compassion upon the human race.

Offertory Exodus 13: 5 GR 210

In die solemnitatis vestrae, dicit Dominus, inducam vos in terram flue tem lac et mel, alleluia.

In the day of your solemnity, saith the Lord, I will bring you into a land that floweth with milk and honey, alleluia.

Communion 1 Peter 2: 9 GR 210

Populus acquisitionis, annuntiate virtutes ejus, alleluia: qui vos de tenebris vocavit in admirabile lumen suum. alleluia.

People whom God had purchased, declare the virtues, alleluia: of Him who has called you out of darkness into His admirable light, alleluia.

Friday in the Octave of Easter Mass I, Lux et Origo Gloria GR 710

Introit psalm 77: 53,1 GR 211

Eduxit eos Dominus in spe, alleluia: et inimicos eorum operuit mare, alleluia.

The Lord brought them out in safety, alleluia, whilst the sea overwhelmed their enemies, alleluia.

Gradual psalm 117: 26,27 GR 212

Haec dies, quam fecit Dominus exsultemus, et laetemur in ea. V Benedixius, qui venit in nomine Domini: Deus Dominus, et illuxit nobis.

This is the day that the Lord has made: let us be rejoice and be glad in it. V Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord: the Lord is truly God and He hath shone forth unto us.

Alleluia psalm 95: 10 GR 212

Dicite in gentibus: quia Dominus regnavit a ligno.

Say ye among the nations: that the Lord hath reigned from a tree.

Sequence as for Monday GR 198

Offertory Exodus 12: 14 GR 213

Erit vobis haec dies memorialis, alleluia: e diem festum celebrabitis solemnem Domino in progenies vestras: legitimum sempiternum diem, alleluia.

This day shall be for a memorial to you, alleluia: and you shall keep it a solemn feast to the Lord from generation to generation: an everlasting legal day, alleluia.

Communion Matthew 28: 18-19 GR 213
Data est mihi omnis potestas in caelo, et in terra, alleluia: euntes, docete omnes gentes, baptizantes eos in nomine Patris, et Filii, et Spiritus Sancti, alleluia, alleluia.
All power is given to Me in heaven and on earth, alleluia: going, teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, alleluia.

Saturday in the Octave of Easter Mass I, Lux et Origo Gloria GR 710
Introit psalm 104: 43 et 1 GR 214
Eduxit Dominus populum suum in exultatione, alleluia: et electos suos in laetitia, alleluia, alleluia.
The Lord brought forth His people with joy, alleluia: and His chosen ones with gladness, alleluia.

Alleluia psalm 117: 24 GR 214
Haec dies, quam fecit Dominus exultemus, et laetemur in ea. Laudate, pueri, Dominum, laudate nomen Domini.
This is the day that the Lord has made: let us be rejoice and be glad in it. Praise the Lord, O ye His servants, praise the name of the Lord.

Benedictus, qui venit in nomine Domini: benediximus vobis de domo Domini: Deus Dominus, et illuxit nobis, alleluia alleluia
Blessed be He that cometh in the name of Lord! We have blessed you out of the house of the Lord. God is the Lord and hath shone upon us. Alleluia

Communion Galations 3: 7 GR 61
Omnes qui in Christo baptizati estis, Christum induistis alleluia.
All you who have been baptised in Christ have put on Christ Alleluia
