Tuesday 26th May week VIII in Ordinary time I Mass IV. GR 725

Introit psalm 17. 19,20 & 2-3 GR 281

Factus est Dominus protector meus, et eduxit me in latitudinem: salvum me fecit, quoniam voluit me. V. Diligam te Domine fortitudo mea: Dominus firmamentum meum, et refugium meum et liberator meus.

The Lord became my protector. He brought me out to a place of freedom; He saved me because He delighted in me. V I will love you always, O Lord my strength; the Lord is my support, my refuge and my deliverer.

Gradual psalm 119, 1 V 2 GR 282

Ad Dominum, dum tribularer, clamavi, et exaudivit me. V Domine, libera animam meam a labiis iniquis, et a lingua dolosa.

In my distress I cried to the Lord and He heard me. V O Lord, deliver my soul from the wicked lips and from a deceitful tongue.

Alleluia psalm 7. 2 GR 282

Domine Deus meus, in te speravi: salvum me fac ex omnibus persequentibus me, et libera me. O, Lord, my God, I have put my trust in You; save me from all those who persecute me.

Offertory psalm 6. 5 GR 283

Domine convertere, et eripe animam meam: salvum me fac propter misericordiam tuam. Turn to me, O Lord, and deliver my soul; save me for the sake of Your love.

Communion Matthew 19: 28,29 GR 436

Amen dico vobis: quod vos, qui reliquistis omnia, et secuti estis me, centuplum accipietis, et vitam aeternam possidebitis.

Amen, I say to you, that you who have left everything and followed Me, shall receive a hundredfold and shall possess life everlasting.

Cibavit Eos ex adipe frumenti, alleluia: et de petra melle saturavit eos, alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.

He fed them with the finest wheat, alleluia; and satisfied them with honey from the rock, alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.

Gradual psalm 109. 4 V 1 GR 486

Iuravit Dominus,, et non paenitebit eum: Tu es sacerdos in aeternum, secundum ordinem Melchisedech. V Dixit Dominus Domino meo: Sede a dextris meis

The Lord has sworn an oath he will not change: you are a priest for ever in the line of Melchizadek. The Lord's revelation to my Lord: sit at My right hand.

Dominus mea, domus orationi vocabitur, dicit Dominus: in ea omnis, qui petit, accipit: et qui quaerit, invenit, et pulsanti aperietur

My house shall be called the house of prayer, saith the Lord: in it every one that asketh receiveth: and he that seeketh findeth; to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Alleluia psalm 20: 4 GR 480

Posuisti, Domine, super caput eius coronam de lapide prestioso.

O Lord, Thou hast set on his head a crown of precious stones.

Offertory psalm 8: 6-7 GR 434

Gloria et honore coronasti eum: et constituisti eum super opera manuum tuarum, Domine.

Thou hast crowned him with glory and honour: and hast set him over the works of Thy hands, O Lord.

Communion Matthew 16: 24 GR 484

Qui vult venire post me, abneget se metipsum: et tollat crucem suam, et sequatur me.

If any man would come after me let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.

This is My Body which shall be delivered for you: this chalice is the new testament in My Blood, saith the Lord: do this, as often as you receive it, in commemoration of Me.
